

## **5th Grade Supplies List**

Supplies to be purchased at School- Please send in \$25.00 in a sealed envelope with your child's full name and grade to cover the costs of these items (***Students will receive these items once the fee is paid in full***):

- Homework planner
- Communication folder
- 8 pocket folder
- Behavior folder
- 1 Scientific Calculator(***students will use these calculators for each remaining school year***)

### **Supplies to be purchased for the student by the first day of school:**

- 9 composition copybooks(***Do not purchase spiral books***)
- 2 soft cover pencil cases with multiple compartments (***Do not purchase plastic pencil cases as they can easily tear. Do not purchase plastic/medal pencil case boxes as they can easily break and may cause distractions when they fall on the floor.***) • 4 (#2) pencils daily
- 1 large pencil eraser daily
- 2 black pens daily
- 1 pack of multi-color pens
- 4 black Expo dry erase markers and a white board eraser
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack of crayons (***24 count***)
- 1 pack of colored pencils (***24 count***)
- 2 packs of loose leaf paper (***Wide Ruled***)
- 1 index card box with index card dividers
- 2 packs of 300 count 3x5 lined index cards
- 1 12 inch ruler with inches and centimeter measurements
- 1 protractor
- 1 triangular ruler
- 1 Merriam Webster's Elementary Dictionary (***new edition***)
- 4 boxes of tissue
- 3 packs of hand wipes (***No liquid hand sanitizers***)
- 3 packs of disinfectant wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 large backpack(***Please ensure it is strong and durable so that it can withstand the wear and tear throughout the school year***)
